13 Sep 1789. The Bank of New York made the first-ever loan to the United States government, lending \$200,000 to help pay the salaries of President George Washington and members of Congress.

14 Sep 1848. Alexander Stewart opens the first US department store, The Marble Palace, in downtown New York City.

15 Sep 1963. Four young African-American girls are killed by the bombing of a church in Birmingham, Alabama.

16 Sep 2019. Guantánamo Bay is the world's most expensive prison at US\$13 million per prisoner, according to investigation by "The New York Times."

17 Sep 2018. 50 girls treated in hospital in Kaya, Burkina Faso after illegal botched circumcisions.

18 Sept 1830. Tom Thumb, the first locomotive built in the United States, loses a nine-mile race in Maryland to a horse.

19 Sep 1893. New Zealand becomes the first country to grant all women the right to vote.
